
CAST: SUPPORTING ARTISTS



CREW: EDITOR CHLOE HARDWICK





To meet the completion deadline, the shoot will take place in January. Therefore all outdoor locations are being considered with accessible bases nearby to accommodate for inclement weather.





SHOOTING APPROACH

We are aware of the ambitious nature of the production. Telling a story that takes us to numerous locations while portraying engaging characters, it is crucial to have an enthusiastic and skilled team. Having worked together on numerous projects, we've developed a shorthand that creates an efficient production process allowing a limited budget to stretch far. We are used to working to tight budgets and fixed deadlines and are confident that we can pull in any finances needed. Our past shoots have included: working with animals and children; shooting outside in winter; working with older actresses; no budget films.

We will be developing the characters using a workshop process that we have seen work successfully at the Old Vic. We intend to use the actors' own experiences, memories and individual traits to enrich the script, creating well-rounded, unique and believable protagonists.

With our combined industry experience, we have many contacts in camera and kit houses as well as post-production facilities. We have also built up good will among wider industry, which we can draw upon for extra resources. Response to the project has been very positive and we will capitalise on this.

For example, having organised many events at post-production, we have contacts at Blackmagic and the Red Digital Cinema Camera Company. We are in the process of negotiating a case study scheme whereby one company would produce a write up of the production of Along with You in exchange for using their kit. This would not only help our budget but also provide great marketing opportunities for the film.
